

## 2011 Competitions

### During AGFEST

During your visit to AGFEST, students can follow the Yellow Brick Road trail around the site. This trail includes giveaways for students to collect. This trail also involves a quiz competition, where students gather information about the different exhibits at AGFEST. Students return the completed quiz to a drop off box inside the Rural Youth Feature tent. Each day, a prize will be given to a randomly drawn entry which contains the correct answers.

### Prior to AGFEST

- K-2  
Design a piece of art work using fruit & vegetables. Be creative with how the fruit is used (printing, using like a brush etc).

2<sup>ND</sup> -\$40  
3<sup>RD</sup> -\$30
- Middle to Upper Primary (3-6) Unsafe farm picture.  
Look at the farm picture and work out all the unsafe aspects of it. Recreate the picture to make it safe.  
1<sup>ST</sup> -\$50  
2<sup>ND</sup> -\$40  
3<sup>RD</sup> -\$30
- Grades 7-12  
Create a 15-30 sec radio advertisement, power point or poster about 3 aspects of farm safety. First, second and third places will be displayed or advertised at AGFEST over the PA.  
1<sup>ST</sup> -\$50  
2<sup>ND</sup> -\$40  
3<sup>RD</sup> -\$30
- Individual and class category.  
Design a letterbox for a country farm gate. Letter boxes will be undercover during AGFEST. The public will vote for their favourite letterbox.  
Individual category-\$50  
Class category - \$100

All competition winners will receive book vouchers as their prize. Please make sure all competitions are clearly named with students name, grade and school.
